PAYMENT OPTIONS/RECEIPTS

The Fall and Winter course fees are due the day before each course starts.

COURSE WITHDRAWAL/REFUNDS POLICY

To withdraw from a course(s) without incurring **academic and financial penalty**, students **must** email the Distance Nursing Program Office at distance.nursing@stfx.ca.

Emailing the Instructor, or other departments, is NOT an official withdrawal from a course. Your email must be sent from your StFX email account to the Distance Nursing Program Office at distance.nursing@stfx.ca.

Without proper notification, a student remains on the class lists. Thus, absence from exams and other requirements will result in a failure on the student's university transcript.

Not participating in a course, not logging into Moodle, or not reviewing your StFX email account does NOT remove you from the course. If you have not submitted a withdrawal email to the Distance Nursing Program Office, you are still responsible for the fees owed.

- *If a student **withdraws up to and including the day** the online course begins, and has paid the tuition fees in advance, they are eligible for a full tuition refund.*
- *If a student **withdraws in the first week**, 2/3 of the tuition will be refunded. If fees were not paid in advance, 1/3 of the course fee is owed.*
- *If a student **withdraws in the second week**, 1/3 of the tuition will be refunded. If fees were not paid in advance, 2/3 of the course fee is owed.*
- ***During or after the third week** after the course starts, no refund is issued. If fees were not paid in advance, the full course fee is owed.*



If you are eligible for a refund, please email Student Accounts at studentaccounts@stfx.ca from your StFX email account and include your StFX ID and the number and name of the course(s) you have dropped.

SPRING/SUMMER REGISTRATION

Registration details for Spring/Summer 2022 courses will be included in the **February Newsletter**.

IEN students will need to email distance.nursing@stfx.ca to request registration when registration opens in February.

Emails must come from your StFX email account.

Students are registered on a first come, first serve basis.

Registration requests must be emailed AFTER registration opens in February!

Post-RN BScN students can register themselves into their selected courses when registration opens in February.

STUDENT EMAIL ACCOUNTS

All students are **required** to check their StFX email account on a regular basis and keep the inbox open for deliveries by deleting unnecessary emails and changing passwords as required. All information coming from the Program Office, as well as other university offices, will be sent to your StFX email account only.

Emails from your personal email accounts often get caught in the spam filter and may go unnoticed. PLEASE USE YOUR STFX EMAIL ACCOUNT WHEN CONTACTING THE PROGRAM OFFICE AND ALWAYS INCLUDE YOUR STUDENT ID NUMBER TO EXPEDITE YOUR REQUESTS.
