StFX Human Kinetics students are able to study abroad with Charles University's Faculty of Physical Education and Sports. The Faculty of Physical Education and Sport, Charles University, was incorporated into Charles University as an Institute of Physical Education and Sport in 1959, and as a Faculty in 1965. Its mission is to educate and train professionals in sport and physical education (for children, adults and seniors, with and without special needs), military physical education, civil protection education, sport management, recreation and physiotherapy. The Bachelors and Masters programs are grounded in both theory and practice. The study programs of Physiotherapy and Physical Education and Sport are also taught in English.

Course Requirements:	Exchange students are expected to take 30 ECTS credits per semester of study. 30 ECTS credits are equal to 15 credits at StFX. 6 ECTS credits are equal to 3 credits at StFX.
Course Restrictions:	In addition to Human Kinetics courses, there are also a wide variety of Human Kinetics 'skills' that can be taken at Charles.

## ACCOMMODATIONS

<b>Type of Accommodation:</b>	On Campus Residence

<b>Cost:</b>	~3800 CZK per month. (Equivalent to approximately \$220 CAD)
<b>Details:</b>	<p>Accommodation is provided in Charles University Halls of Residence. Only double-rooms are available. Bedding and bed linen are provided, towels and kitchen utensils are not.</p> <p>There are two types of rooms:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- A unit system consisting of two double rooms sharing small kitchenette (hot plate and small fridge) and bathroom facilities.</li> <li>- Double rooms with communal showers and kitchens at the end of each hall.</li> </ul> <p>If students wish to find accommodation off campus they are welcome to do so, but are asked to inform the exchange coordinator if that is what they choose.</p>

## OTHER COSTS

<b>Health Insurance:</b>	<p>All StFX students are required to purchase travel health insurance for the duration of their time abroad. <a href="#">Link</a></p> <p>Additionally, students applying for a visa to study in the Czech Republic must have a valid international medical insurance plan that will need to be provided when applying for the visa. <a href="#">Link</a></p>
<b>Living Expenses:</b>	<a href="#">Link</a>
<b>Visa:</b>	<p>Students will need to apply for a 'long-term visa' to study for more than three months in the Czech Republic. After your application to Charles has been accepted, you will receive a letter of acceptance and accommodation agreement that will be used when applying for the visa. The cost of the visa is ~\$140 CAD. <a href="#">Link</a></p> <p><i>*Please note that travel to the nearest Czech consulate or embassy will be required to apply for the long-term visa.</i></p>
