Health Insurance:	All StFX students are required to purchase travel health insurance for the duration of their time abroad. Link Additionally, as part of the student visa requirements, students will need to provide proof of health insurance valid for the duration of their time in Spain. Link	
Living Expenses:	<u>Link</u>	
Visa:	Canadian students need a student visa to complete an exchange in Spain. IN addition to the application form you will also need to provide confirmation of school registration (provided by CEU), proof of insurance, proof of finances, a medical certificate and a police check. The cost is \$125 CAD. Link Full-year exchange students will need to apply for a student residence permit in addition to the student visa. CEU will assist with this process. *Please note that travel to the nearest Spanish consulate or embassy will be required to apply for the student visa.
