Heriot Watt University is the eighth oldest higher education institution in the UK and originated as the School of Arts of Edinburgh, the world's first mechanics institute, in 1821. The University has multiple campuses, with three in Scotland, and one each in Malaysia and Dubai (Note: StFX students are limited to studying at the campus in Edinburgh). The main campus is located in South West Edinburgh on 380 acres of parkland. The campus consists of academic buildings, student residences, a postgraduate centre, shops, several library collections, childcare, healthcare, a chaplaincy, a variety of recreational and sports facilities, and a museum, as well as the Student Union's main premises.

Course Requirements:	Exchange students are expected to take 60 UK credits per semester of study. 60 UK credits are equal to 15 credits at StFX. Courses at HW are worth 15 UK credits each. Therefore, 4 courses at HW are equivalent to 5 courses at StFX.	
Course Restrictions:	Course availability is subject to pre-requisites and timetabling. Please pay careful attention to course levels when selecting courses. • Level 7 = First year, introductory level. • Level 8 = Second year, prior knowledge in subject area likely to be required. • Level 9 = Third year, significant prior knowledge in subject area is required. • Level 10 = Fourth year, normally not open to study abroad students.

Health Insurance:	All StFX students are required to purchase travel health insurance for the duration of their time abroad. Link Additionally, full-year exchange students to the U.K. will be required to pay an immigration health surcharge (£470) as part of their student visa application fee.
