The university has four campuses: Streatham and St Luke's (both of which are in Exeter); and Truro and Penryn (both of which are in Cornwall). The university is primarily located in the city of Exeter, Devon, where it is the principal higher education institution. Streatham is the main campus, sitting on a hillside one side of which looks down across Exeter city centre. The campus has several galleries, the Bill Douglas Cinema Museum, a theatre, two bars, a medical centre, a counselling service, a children's day-care centre and numerous catering outlets. Many halls of residence and some self-catering accommodation are located on this campus or in the near vicinity.

Course Requirements:	Exchange students are expected to take 60 UK credits per semester of study. 60 UK credits are equal to 15 credits at StFX. 10 UK credits are equal to 3 credits at StFX.
Course Restrictions:	StFX students are not able to take courses from the College of Medicine and Health, Liberal Arts Department, Psychology Department, or the Graduate School of Education. Choosing modules (courses) from across different departments and levels will increase the possibility of timetable clashes. This can make finalizing your study program more difficult, so please choose a minimum of 50% of your modules in one subject area.

Health Insurance:	All StFX students are required to purchase travel health insurance for the duration of their time abroad. <u>Link</u> Additionally, full-year exchange students to the U.K. will be required to pay an <u>immigration health surcharge</u> (£470) as part of their student visa application fee.
